DENVER — Angelina Jolie and Brad Pitt's baby has made what may be her first fashion statement, appearing on the cover of People magazine (inset) in a US\$42 (S\$67) T-shirt sold by a Denver boutique — and triggering a tidal wave of orders.

Belly, a shop in Denver's tony Cherry Creek district, had sent Jolie one of the T-shirts and some maternity clothes in January. It was not clear whether the shirt in the cover photo was the same one sent by Belly.

The shirt worn by little Shiloh Nouvel Jolie-Pitt says The Pots & Pans Band in Gothic letters and features a skull and crossbones, an eagle and some pots and pans.

After People hit newsstands last week, Belly was deluged with telephone and Internet orders for the T-shirt and it quickly sold out. More are on order.
